If you have any questions or concerns about camp, please contact the Camp Director at 630-219-8767.

Camp check in is between 8:00 and 8:30 a.m. each day. Staff arrives at 7:45 a.m. and that time is needed for staff to adequately prepare for the day ahead. DO NOT drop off your child before 8:00 a.m. Pick-up from camp begins at 3:00 p.m. except on Thursday field trip days when trips might run long. Pick-up continues until 5:30 p.m. All children must be picked up by the latest of 5:30 p.m.

What to Bring to Camp Each Day

Please put camper's name on everything!

- Sack lunch, drink and two snacks. There is no refrigerator; pack lunch accordingly.
- A filled, inexpensive water bottle.
- Sweatshirt or jacket.
- Gym shoes.
- A book to read during down time.
- Change of clothes.
- Backpack for belongings. All other personal belongings should remain at home unless specifically needed at camp.

Rainy Days

We are pleased to announce that we offer Rainout Line – a convenient way to find out if Park District activities are cancelled or facilities are closed due to weather.

Day camps will never be cancelled due to inclement weather. However, they will need to move indoors when necessary. When unsure of the weather, please check where camp will meet or if it might have moved during the day due to the changing weather.

Park District participants can use Rainout Line and choose to get their information in five different ways:

1. Call the Rainout Line number at 630-883-4242
2. Visit napervilleparks.org/cancellations or go to our website and click on the Weather Cancellations & Closures tab (in red at top of homepage)
3. Opt-in to receive email updates*
4. Opt-in to receive text updates*
5. Download the free smartphone app*

*To select any of these options, visit the Naperville Park District's Rainout Line page at napervilleparks.org/cancellations. Then click on the "Email & Text Alerts" link or select the AppStore or Android Market icons to download the app.

Details regarding the current status of activities are segmented by the specific sport or facility. Participants can manage text and/or email subscriptions by selecting the activity or facility (in this case the activity would be "Day Camps") and establishing the length of time for which to receive notifications (in this case you may choose just the dates that your child is registered for camp).

Posts will made by 7:30 a.m. If nothing is posted by 7:30 a.m., Camp LOL will meet at regular outside park pavilion location.
