



Naperville Premier Soccer League (NPSL)

Naperville Premier Soccer University: 1st Grade

NPSU is a great opportunity for 1st grade teams to receive specialized training, while still cultivating a recreational experience. Teams sign up for training sessions one or two times per week and have games with their volunteer coach on Saturdays. Standings are not kept and players should receive equal playing time.

Grades 2-3

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,254 per team.

Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$2,677 per team

Grades 4-6

Grades 7-8

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,569 perm team
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$2,462 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$3,084 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$3,213 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game: \$3,773per team

Training Sessions:

Teams registering for option 1 (league play only) will determine their own practice schedule and location. Lights will not be provided for those teams choosing option 1.

Training slots for teams that choose option #2-#5 will be filled on a first come, first served basis based upon registration date and time. Some locations may have limited availability and if your first or second choice is not available, the NPSL coordinator will contact you about other possible options. Priority will be given to returning teams to secure previous seasons location if team signs up during 1st week of registration.

Training sessions will be one hour per week for nine weeks beginning August 30. Additional practices and locations will be determined by the coach.

Games:

An 8-week game schedule will be played beginning September 11. All games will be played in Naperville on Saturdays. Rain date is November 6 for those games cancelled by the Park District. Game scores and standing will be kept. Awards will be given to first and second place teams at the end of the season. Equal play time is encouraged but not guaranteed; play time is based on coach strategy.

Roster Size:

Grade 1	5v5- 10 maximum on roster
Grades 2-3	7v7 – 14 maximum on roster
Grades 4-6	9v9 – 16 maximum on roster
Grades 7/8	11v11 – 18 maximum on roster



Registration Information:

Team registration. Coaches will register their team online choosing the option and course code that corresponds to their selection.

A \$200 non-refundable deposit or full payment is required at time of registration. Balance will be due July 30, 2021 and is non-refundable after that point.

The last day to register and/or withdraw and receive a refund is July 30, 2021.

Individual registration. Players in grades 2-8 that do not have a team and would like to play and may sign up for a team on their own. Teams will have a dedicated trainer as their coach and will practice one time per week. Volunteer assistant coaches and/or team managers are needed for each team. Early registration is recommended as space is limited. The deadline to register or withdraw and receive a full refund is Friday, July 30. After July 30th, a prorated refund minus the uniform cost will be given up until the start of the program. No refunds will be issued after the program has begun.

Fee: \$242R/\$272NR

Practices will begin the week of August 30. All individual teams will practice at Wolf’s Crossing Community Park. Days and times may be modified based on enrollment.

NPSL Additional Info:

1.Teams will provide their own equipment. Home team is required to provide game ball. It is suggested that each team also have a first aid kit (bandages, gloves, and ice packs).

2. Uniform choice will be determined by team. The only requirements are that each team must have a home and away jersey, jerseys must have numbers on back and team is uniform in jersey, shorts and socks.

NYS blue/gold reversible jerseys may be worn but numbers must be placed on the back. Teams may choose to purchase uniforms on their own or select from options available through Naperville Premiere Soccer League program.

3. Registration is open to anyone that is interested in playing. Teams may be composed of residents and/or non-residents. Nonresidents must pay an additional \$20 fee payable to the Naperville Park District. Players playing on a club team also may play in the Premier league. Club teams may sign up and wear their club uniform.

4. Grade levels may be combined if a sufficient number of teams do not sign up.

5. New players and coaches must come to the park district offices at the Fort Hill Activity Center and obtain a player pass before the start of the season. Coaches will be provide additional information after team is registered.

6. Teams are grade based. Teams must consist of two-thirds of players from grade signed up for. Players may play “up” one year but number is limited to one-third of the team roster. Players may not play “down” in grade level even if age is same of those players in lower grade.
